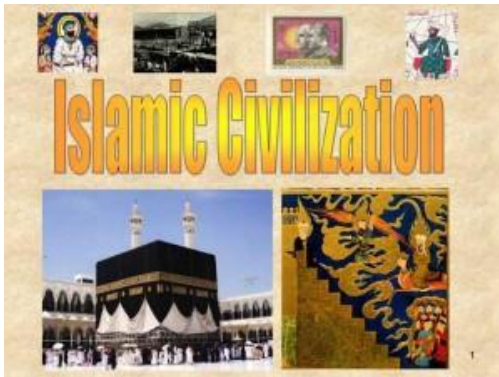


Culturocity - Topic Work
