

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Settle in to nursery and separates from main carer with support.
- Learn and follow the boundaries and routines: Writing a class charter and learning to share and tidy up.
- Play alongside other children in a friendly manner, joining in with their play.
- Feel safe and ask for help if they need it.
- Managing their feelings when children encounter new experiences, eg eating in the hall, group activities.

Literacy

- Has some favourite stories, rhymes and songs.
- Enjoy rhyming activities.
- Enjoy listening to stories and repeats words or phrases from familiar stories.
- Look at books and handle them carefully.
- Enjoy making marks with pens, pencils and brushes and begin to give meaning to their marks.

Expressive art and design

- Join in singing nursery rhymes and songs.
- Join in with ring games and dance, learning to move expressively to music.
- Explore the sounds of instruments.
- Engage in imaginative role-play.
- Use various construction materials.
- Explore and experiment with colour and textures.

Communication and Language

- Join in with nursery rhymes and songs.
- Listen to other children and familiar stories in a small group.
- Children share their photo and chat to their key worker about it
- Talk in simple sentences.
- Is able to talk about what they are doing.

Understanding the World

- Explore the technological toys and interactive whiteboard.
- Talk about their own lives and experiences and take on familiar roles in imaginative play.
- Explore the Nursery garden and discovering plants and mini-beasts.
- Playing with small- world models.

Physical Development

- Run steadily in the garden and climb steps and stairs safely.
- Move freely with pleasure and confidence in a range of ways, inside, outside and in the school hall.
- Show control when using small equipment such as scissors, glue spreaders, rollers.
- Practise putting their coats on.
- Show independence pouring drinks and managing snack.
- Being able to use the toilet and wash hands independently

Mathematics

- Join in with number songs and rhymes.
- Say some number names in their play.
- Show an interest and curiosity in numbers.
- Count objects to 5, pointing to each object as they count.
- Plays with patterns and shapes, for example using blocks and construction kits.
- Begin to use the language of size, e.g. playing with sand and water and exploring capacity.
