Using the text 'The Egyptian Cinderella', we will explore traditional stories set in other cultures. We shall then write our own version of a traditional story, setting it in Ancient Egypt.

Computing

We shall be looking at coding and how to write code for creating computer games. We will be using an online resource called Scratch, which is easily accessible at home if children want to have a go at home!

Geography

We will be using maps and atlases to study the geography of Egypt; the three seasons of the Nile and the impact it has on farming.

History

After breaking into the tomb of Tutankhamen, the children will explore the Ancient Egyptians including: The Nile, Tutankhamen, Gods, Pharaohs, Pyramids, burials and rituals, hieroglyphics.

Maths

This half term will focus largely on multiplication and division and the formal written methods for these operations.

We will also look at factors and multiples and how to use known facts from our times tables to solve trickier calculations.

Later in the term, we will look at fractions and decimals. This will include adding and subtracting fractions, equivalent fractions, and finding a fraction of a quantity e.g. $\frac{3}{4}$ of 20. Children will recognise tenths, hundredths and $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ as decimals.

Science

We will be looking at sound, finding out how it is made, how it travels and how pitch is changed.

Art

We will use geometric shapes to help draw and paint Egyptian Gods. The children will design and create a cartouche from clay.
