Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you so much for your support over the last three weeks in helping your children settle into Nursery. Hopefully all our hard work has paid off as most children seem very happy to come in and get stuck into their play and learning!

A few requests:

- Please ensure you are as punctual as possible for drop-offs and pick-ups and we will endeavour to do the same, to avoid congestion around the school site. Drop off and pick up should be at the Nursery entrance on Shrubbery lane except in exceptional circumstances.

Morning drop off: 8.45
Lunch club drop off: 11.40
Morning pick up: 11.45
After lunch collection: 12.15
Afternoon drop off: 12.15
Afternoon pick up: 3.15

- If you have not yet engaged with our Tapestry posts, please log on and do so as it is particularly important at this time when we have fewer opportunities to chat informally with you. It will also be our main way of communicating and sending learning ideas home, should we need to support home learning at any stage.
- Please ensure lunch boxes and water bottles are named as lots of children have similar ones. If it is possible to put the water bottle in the lunch box. **MAKE SURE LUNCHES CONTAIN NO PEANUTS** as a child in Nursery has an allergy.
- Please label coats and jumpers which your child might take off.
- Please do not send children to school in shoes with laces or in open-toed shoes as they can be dangerous.

Under normal circumstances we would have parent consultations in the Autumn term but this year we shall be phoning you towards half term for a brief chat to let you know how your child is getting on and answer any queries. Around this time we shall also be letting you know who your child's Key Worker is, once we have got to know all the children and seen where attachments naturally fall with the different adults.
