Exploring that some forces need contact between two objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance Observing how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others Comparing and grouping together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet, and identify some magnetic materials Describing magnets as having two poles Predicting whether two magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing</p>
