We will be able to explain what a prime number, composite number, factor and multiple are. Measurement: Area and Perimeter. We will be able to calculate area and perimeter of 2D shapes.</p>
<p><u>Spellings</u> Our focus will be on the Year 5 and 6 statutory words and some revision of the Year 3 and 4 statutory words. In addition, we will look at homophones, plural spelling rules, hyphens and the use of apostrophes.
