We will be using what we have learnt to write amazing and awesome museum guides for our Stone Age Museum.</p> <p>Portal stories: We will be learning all about the structure of portal stories, using texts such as Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura and The Wild Way Home by Sophie Kirtley. We will also be introducing the children to written dialogue, identifying the common features and exploring how to use it within a story.</p>	<p>Maths Multiplication and Division: We will be learning how to multiply and divide 2 digits by 1 digit.</p> <p>Money: We will be learning to talk about money as pounds and pence. We will also be using money to add, subtract and make change.</p> <p>Statistics: We will be drawing and interpreting a range of different pictograms, bar and tally charts. We will be using our knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times table to help us solve statistical problems.</p> <p>We will be using what we have learnt to solve a range of mathematical problems.</p>	<p>Art We are going to develop our charcoal skills, using it to sketch the natural world around us. We will then be investigating cave art before learning how to make our own paint from natural materials. We will be using this to create our own cave paintings.</p> <p>French We will be learning how to say the names of different colours and different parts of the body. We will be using our new vocabulary to design and label a French monster.</p>

Children will create different characters and learn how to move them in different ways.</p>

We will be exploring the Hindu belief that there is one God with many different aspects.</p>	<p>Forest Schools – 3B We will be exploring our school grounds and learning about our impact on the environment around us.</p>	<p>Music – 3CR We will be learning all about the different instruments in the orchestra. We will be exploring how these instruments are used in the Carnival of the Animals by Camille Saint-Saens.</p>

We will learn the rules of hockey and apply our new skills when playing matches.</p>	<p>History We will be examining the time period from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will be learning all about hunter-gatherers in the Stone Age and examining what they left behind in the archaeological record. We will be discovering the mysteries of Stonehenge and how bronze is smelted.
