

<p><u>English</u> Writing legends – We will write a legend about overcoming a monster. This will be linked to different adventures through time. Writing discussion texts. The children will develop arguments for and against allowing unusual creatures from adventure stories to roam free.</p>	<h1 style="text-align: center;">Year 5 – Spring 1 Adventures Through Time!</h1>	<p><u>Maths</u> Multiplication and Division: We will learn the written methods for multiplying by 1 and 2 digits and learn the written method for dividing by a one-digit divisor. Measurement: Fractions. We will explore what a fraction is and begin to identify equivalent fractions.</p>
<p><u>Spellings</u> Our focus will be on the Year 5 and 6 statutory words and some revision of the Year 3 and 4 statutory words. In addition, we will look at apostrophes for possession, words ending in ably and ibly, homophones and unusual spellings.
