Personal Profile

I moved to Wyke Regis in September 2019 when my husband took up the post as Rector of All Saints Church. After meeting on a train in the South of France in the summer of 1986, we married in June 1988 and have lived as a family in Kent, France and Derby before moving to Dorset. We have three grown up children and four grandchildren aged 5, 7, 10 and 13.

I became a Christian at the age of 14, after having attended Sunday School as a child and Youth Group as a teenager. I have always had a love for children and soon began teaching 3-5 year olds in Sunday School after finding faith in Jesus. As a graduate, I worked for 4 years with children aged 7-18 in a therapeutic children's home before getting married and having a family.

When my children were small, I set up a Parent and Toddler Group and volunteered as Secretary of the Pre-School Committee attached to the local C of E Primary School. I now work part time for Dorset Council as a Family Worker in the Early Help Team for Weymouth and Portland. I also lead a Parent and Toddler Group at St Edmunds Church Hall each Wednesday in term time.

I am delighted to be able to join the team of governors at Wyke Regis Primary Federation where I hope to contribute positively to the spiritual as well as the educational life of the school. My desire is to inspire pupils and staff alike to have a living faith in the God who loves us, and to share His love and care for all of creation.
