



<p>English Persuasive Texts: We will be learning all about the structure of persuasive texts. We will be using what we have learnt to write a leaflet (pretending to be Mary Anning) persuading people to visit our new museum full of terrifying skeletons.</p> <p>Action and plot: We will be exploring how to create exciting action sequences in our writing, looking deeply at how different types of vocabulary and different sentence types can make our writing very exciting to read. We will also be exploring the different types of plots in stories and identifying which are best suited to action writing. Our books this half-term is Stone Girl, Bone Girl by Laurence Anholt.</p>	<p>Maths Statistics: We will be drawing and interpreting a range of different pictograms, bar and tally charts. We will be using our knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times table to help us solve statistical problems.</p> <p>Measurement, length and perimeter: We will be measuring and comparing different lengths. We will be using this knowledge to add and subtract different lengths. We will also be measuring and calculating the perimeters of a range of different shapes.</p> <p>We will be using what we have learnt to solve a range of mathematical problems.</p>	<p>DT We will be revisiting our work on electrical circuits from the Autumn Term.
