## Dear Parents and Carers,

We would all like to take this opportunity to welcome you and your child to Year 5. We hope that they will find the coming academic year enjoyable, exciting and challenging. We are kick starting our year with our topic of 'Join the Team' and 'Healthy Heart, Healthy Mind'. In the second half of the term, on the fabulous build up to Christmas, our topic is 'Out of this World'. This is when the children will get the opportunity to explore the Earth Sciences, work on the planets and the solar system. Please see the attached topic web for more information about this half terms topic; we will send information about the other topic after half term.

Homework in the autumn term will consist of spelling and times tables practice. This is best completed daily, 10-15 minutes each day, rather than all in one go. In addition, there will be a topic-based homework project to be completed across each half term. Your child has been given a log in for Mathletics, Google Classroom, Accelerated Reader, Times Table Rock Stars and Google Classroom which are websites designed to support their learning. Please take some time to log on with your child and explore these sites. Please encourage your child to use these sites regularly and at times we will set specific activities for them to complete at home. Many messages and reminders for the children are loaded onto Google Classroom, so we ask children to log in regularly to check for updates and additional home learning activities or challenges.

We want to continue to foster confident readers who have a love of books. Please help us by ensuring that your child is reading regularly at home for at least 20 minutes at a time and recording this in their reading record. Please also sign your child's reading record to confirm that they have been reading at home. We have lots of exciting rewards in school for children that are reading at home but they will only qualify for these if you sign their record.

A full school uniform list is available on our school website. However, we would like to remind you that socks should be plain black, grey or white and not trainer socks; hair accessories should be simple and in school appropriate colours; jewellery is limited to plain, round stud earrings and a watch; and nail varnish

should not be worn. Children are to wear their school PE kit on PE days, which are on Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday mornings. (school purple hoodie, black leggings or black track suit bottoms and trainers).

Please ensure everything is named including coats, lunch-boxes and jumpers as this will mean it is more likely that lost property will find its way back to the classroom.

It is important that your child brings a named water bottle to school and we encourage them to drink water (not juice as per the school policy) throughout the day. They should also bring in a piece of fruit for a snack at playtime.

Your child will **not need** to bring in any stationery or pencil cases. All this will be provided in school, so keep your lovely items safe at home.

In Year 5 children often walk home on their own. If your child is not allowed to do this, please let the school office know on the email below.
