We will be using 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown as an example of how to do this wonderfully before writing our own sequels.</p> <p>Biographies: We will be exploring a range of different biographies, learning about their key features before writing our own for David Attenborough.</p>	<p>Maths Addition and Subtraction: We will be continuing to learn how to use the formal column methods to add and subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers.</p> <p>Multiplication and Division: We will be learning how to multiply and divide by 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10. We will be introducing the 4 and 8 times tables and investigating the link between the 2 and 4 times table and then the 4 and 8 times tables.</p> <p>We will be using what we have learnt to solve a range of mathematical problems.</p>	<p>Science Light We will be learning all about the difference between light and dark. We will explore how shadows change during the day and how shadows are created.
